The Division of Mass Spectrometry of the Italian Chemical Society (DSM-SCI) awards **10 fellowships** for the participation of young researchers to the conference **5th MS-Wine Day** that will be held in Asti (Italy) on 22th, 24th May 2024.

The fellowships are reserved to young researchers under 35 years **at 30th March 2024** with no permanent position jobs who are engaged in scientific or educational activities at Universities, research and control Centers (i.e. PhD, post-doc students and scholarship holders) and which are effective member of the Division of Mass Spectrometry-SCI for the 2024.

The prescribed requirements must be met on the deadline for the application submission and the age limit is extended by six months for each child born or adopted before the deadline. Each fellowship consists in free registration and a travel/accommodation reimbursement, upon deposit of original receipts for travel and accommodation expenses incurred, up to € 150,00.

They must be accompanied by:

- a) A short curriculum vitae;
- b) Applicant's status declared by his/her supervisor;
- c) Title and abstract of a communication to be submitted as oral communication;
- d) Card Number of effective member of the Division of Mass Spectrometry-SCI for the 2024
- e) copy of the identity document of each child for whom an extension of the age limit is requested.
- f) the mail subject should report: **Fellowships 5th MS_Wine Day 2024**

Fellowships will be assigned by an external commission and recipients will be informed by **April 10th, 2024**.

The provision of the fellowship must be acknowledged in the oral presentation if it will be selected by using the logo of DSM-SCI. This logo must only be used for this presentation and must be deleted from the recipient's computer following the presentation.
